Call to Order

- 1) Approve Agenda – Motion by Ron Stroven to approve as amended. **In Favor 4-0**
- 2) Approve Minutes of 2/12/18 – Motion by Ron Stroven to approve as amended. **In Favor 4-0**
- 3) Treasurer’s report Fund Balance \$309,863.24 Restricted amount \$63,335.88 Available for township operations \$246,527.36. Motion by Tom Deater to approve Treasurer’s report. **In Favor 4-0**
- 4) Public Comment: (Please limit comments to three minutes)
 - a) Martha Meyette advised there would be meetings on March 21st and April 19th at 1:30 – 3:00 pm to discuss potential millage and as an educational forum to describe and discuss programming available for elders and their families.
- 5) Committee Reports:
 - a. Fire board meeting minutes were presented by Ron Stroven.

9) Board discussion

- a) Marijuana legislation including Opt-in or Opt-out requirements of the Township: Tom Deater emailed MTA and they advised him the Township does not have to make a decision at this time. If the government approves Marijuana operations, then the township will need to move on a decision.
- b) NSF Checks – Sandy Gustman reported there is an issue with the account for taxes. She is researching and would like input from the Board on how we can keep the account from a negative balance resulting from \$10.00 fee charged for insufficient checks. Is it possible to add \$25 on to the tax bill the County would collect? Sandy requested the Board think about a solution.
- c) Sandy Gustman received a call from Fremont Library offering a Greenwood Township Account Book dating back to 1954. Sandy picked it up.
