

Greenwood Township Board Meeting Minutes

June 12, 2023

1. Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Jeff Hunt.
2. Pledge of Allegiance
3. Roll call – Present Jeff Hunt, Sandy Gustman, Al Deater. Absent- Cora Conley and Stacey Budde.
4. Public Comment – Floastra – What is going on with the sparks grant? Can we close Acker lake off during the winter months? There was a man fishing in her swimming area. Lake is going to be fished out. Who's going to restock the lake? Where are the funds coming from after the grant is finished? Does the DNR publicize to the public that it is public and open to everyone? Jeff Hunt – we will address this at old business.
5. Approve agenda – Sandy Gustman – add street sign to new business. Sandy Gustman made a motion to approve the agenda with additions Al Deater second the motion. All were in favor.

8. Old Business:
 - A) Acker Lake -

Kim McClernan – Fishing on her shore and holding on to her pontoon boat. Fishing in her swimming area and she doesn't like the fishing hooks in that area. Has had to call the sheriff and DNR on people in the past.

Sandy Gustman – The land was designated to the township for everyone to use. It was neglected for years and now were cleaning it up and making it more accessible.

McClernan – Will the township restock the fish? Jeff Hunt – Not a township problem. We pay for weed control and some people who live on Acker lake are not paying for that. You'll have to talk to the DNR about your options on restocking the lake with fish.

Kim McClernan – Permit to fish on the lake? Sandy Gustman – land was set aside for everyone to enjoy the lake. Al Deater – Blue Lake was loaded with fish the DNR put regulations on the lake because they were having fishing problems. Residents will have to call the DNR for info on that.

Mc Clernan – Kids drinking and smoking weed down there, can there be cameras installed down there? Jeff Hunt – He was thinking of installing cameras. Joan David – We have a dawn to dusk sign posted and a no drugs sign posted on their lake.

B) Old Lap Top –

Jeff Hunt – put in the paper for bids? First \$100.00 gets it.

Al Deater – Bring it to J and J online auction? Sandy Gustman wants to make sure it has been wiped clean because it was an elections computer. Jeff Hunt makes a motion to sell the computer to Cora Conley for \$100.00. Al Deater second the motion. All were in favor.

C) Planning Commission – Al Deater – All were present. Ordinance was checked over. Next step will be under the master plan.
